The purpose of this modification is to:

- (1) Exercise the option period, 02 FEB 2012 – 01 FEB 2017, provided for in contract section "F.3 TERM OF CONTRACT AND ORDERS", subject to cited conditions, under the authority cited in Block 13. C, and
- (2) Due to HMS Technologies, Inc's size rerepresentation under FAR 52.219-28 (APR 2009) as other than a small business concern in connection with the option period, after 01 FEB 2012 it may not respond to or accept work as a VETS GWAC prime contractor resulting from any new task order requests (e.g., requests for information, requests for proposals and requests for quotation), including, but not limited to, those resulting from an exception to fair opportunity (continued on page 2)

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

Although as a result of this modification HMS Technologies, Inc is not able to respond to or accept work as a VETS GWAC prime contractor as described above, as a VETS GWAC contractor HMS Technologies, Inc may still be included in the distribution of task order requests which are subject to a fair opportunity to be considered.

If at some time during the option period HMS Technologies, Inc. can rerepresent as a small business concern in accordance with FAR 52.219-28 (APR 2009), and subject to contracting officer approval, HMS Technologies, Inc's status as a prime contractor may be reinstated and the conditions established above removed through a unilateral modification by the VETS GWAC contracting officer.

(3) Identify the rate of adjustment to contract line item ceiling prices per the Escalation Methodology (EM) pre-established at contract sections "B.9 OPTION PERIOD ONE (1) – YEARS SIX (6) THROUGH TEN (10)" and "B.9.1 FREQUENCY OF ADJUSTMENT." For the purpose of contract line item ceiling price escalation the contract's EM incorporates the use of the "Professional, Specialty and Technical" Occupations Occupational Group information from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS). However, the BLS directly replaced that Group with the "Professional and related" Occupational Classification (see attachment 1). Hence, the calculated ceiling price rate of increase is 1.95% (see attachment 2), to be applied as described in B9 - B.9.1. Resulting ceiling prices for the contract option period will be posted on www.gsa.gov/vetsgwac.

The parties agree to these terms and conditions at no additional cost to the government to either party, and all other terms and conditions remain unchanged."

BLS Employment Cost Index (ECI) Occupational Group Replacement Verification

1. How do the SOC occupational indexes compare to OCS indexes?

Tests similar to those used for the industry indexes were used for the occupational indexes.

Table 2 shows information for SOC occupational series. Some series have the same name under the new and old classification systems but are not comparable.
